As a player you must meet the following requirements in regard to your conduct during any event organised by the Club:

- Participate fairly & safely
- Play by the Rules & know the Rules
- Abide by decisions, without argument, bad temper or bad language
- Cooperate with your coaches and other players
- Verbal abuse of officials or other players, deliberately assaulting or provoking an opponent in not acceptable or permitted
- Treat all players as you would like to be treated
- Respect the visitors to the Club, and always respect the club you are visiting
- Be a responsible team member
- Always be on time
- Encourage and assist all players
- Attend all training sessions, Please advise your coach in advance if you are unable to attend a training session
- Ensure you always bring the appropriate shorts and jumpers to training and matches (Home Blue; Away White)
- No bare feet, football boots or sprigs in the clubrooms
- Treat the change rooms and clubrooms as if it were your own (including when we are playing away)
- Unsocial behaviour will not be tolerated
- All alcoholic beverages must be consumed within the marked areas for all home & away games
- Illicit Drugs any member found to be in possession or consuming any prohibited substance will face instant dismissal from the club.

A failure to comply with the Players Code of Conduct will result in appropriate action being taken by the Coolbinia AFC Committee. This includes the possible suspension from play and dismissal from the Club.
